



Summer Camp Internship

Thank you for your interest in being a summer intern for Montana Student Ministries! Each year students/young adults are selected to serve at our Montana Network Summer Camps. Beginning with Family Camp, followed by High School Camp, Glacier Kids Camp and finishing with Middle School Camp. Typically interns are graduating seniors or university-age people. This year we are allowing students entering their senior year of high school to apply.

The internship serves two important purposes:

1. To provide the intern with the opportunity to learn and grow in their faith in Christ and as a servant leader.
2. To provide GBC with competent, consistent help for the weeks of the Network camps.

The time of commitment is from the Wednesday (July 1) night before the start of Family Camp beginning with an orientation that evening and Thursday as a full work day. Provided for the intern are lodging, meals during the week of camp.

Next Steps:

1. Fill out the Internship Application. Give the application to your pastor to be signed and then mailed to the Network Office in care of Summer Camp Internship on or postmarked by April 30, 2021. The sooner we receive them the better, as we pray over them seeking out God's heart for these positions.
2. You will receive notification of acceptance by mid May.
