SEPTEMBER

- Prayerfully consider what the vision for your Fine Arts ministry will look like this year.
- Pray for God to help you identify gifted people who can lead and coach your Fine Arts students.
- Consider what group categories you might want to offer students.
- Familiarize yourself with the Fine Arts Festival Rulebook found online.
- Incorporate a student presentation into one of your youth gatherings...could be a short sermon, instrument solo, drama, etc...



OCTOBER



- Recruit coaches for your desired group categories.
- Create a Fine Arts budget and reach out to your lead pastor for any budget allowances or scholarship potential.
- Create a Fine Arts Informational Packet for students and parents.
- Recruit students for a student-led service in January.
- Reach out to MSM for any questions you have about the rulebook.
- If you have a fall outreach at your church, incorporate your students' entry to share the gospel



NOVEMBER

- Show a Fine Arts video to your students in the weekly youth service to build anticipation.
- Research/Book accommodations in Great Falls.
- Distribute informational packets to students and even have a talented student create the graphics for it.
- Host a Fine Arts parent meeting.
- Reach out to gifted leaders in your church who might serve as evaluators or volunteers for Fine Arts Festival and direct them to MSM.
- Talk to your lead pastor about showcasing a student category on a Sunday morning.



FINE ARTS FESTIVAL



DECEMBER

- Provide the link or distribute copies of the FAF categories and rulebook to your youth and parents.
- Collect commitment forms and put teams together. Then have a meeting to create a plan for what the presentation will look like.
- Have your student artist(s) create Christmas cards for a local nursing home or to send to missionaries.



JANUARY

- Encourage your students to register on the MSM website starting January 1st! Both participating students and spectator students/families need to register to attend.
- Consider a Fine Arts fundraiser.
- Do a check-in with students doing individual categories. A check-in consists of meeting with students doing individual categories and making sure that they know the rules, have a plan, and are staying on track to have their entry ready for March.
- Ask your lead pastor to have a service where your youth can join the Sunday morning worship team.





FEBRUARY

- Continue to encourage your students to get their registrations done.
- Continue practices for group categories.
- Help student do the final edits and submit their writing and video entries.
- Be on the lookout for emails from MSM with details.
- Contact Christine if you or your students still have questions.
- Partner with your Kid's Pastor to have your students lead a portion of Sunday morning Kid's Church.

APRIL

- Celebrate with your church the impact Fine Arts Festival had on your students' lives
- Have a student led service and highlight a specific category
- Connect with your students who received an invitation to National Fine Arts Festival and discuss your plans to attend.
- Invite students who did not advance to come and participate in National Youth Conference and support their fellow student artists.





MAY, JUNE, & JULY

- Finalize plans for NFAF.
- Make sure all registrations are sent in and travel accommodations are set.
- Continue group practices for NFAF.
- Have a student-led service or presentation window during your service.
- Lead a fundraiser for NFAF.
- Recruit students for a student-led service in September.



AUGUST

NATIONAL FINE ARTS FESTIVAL/ NATIONAL YOUTH CONFERENCE MONTH

 Hold a community outreach or back to school bash with your church where you can use student artists to share the gospel.

 Have a student create a promo video for your youth group to share on social media or on a Sunday morning.
